NH SB 274: A Way to Keep State Construction Costs Low and Ensure Pathways into Construction Careers

Protection from the Costs of Beltway Politics

A aterial shortages and workforce challenges already make public construction costs high, but developing federal mandates threaten to push public work projects costs to new heights. Fortunately, SB 274 counters any threats from Washington politics.

SB 274 is about ensuring efficient, accountable, and effective construction spending and investment in New Hampshire, free from unnecessary government-mandates-such as anti-competitive and costly project labor agreements (PLAs)-is a win-win for taxpayers and the economy. New Hampshire deserves an inclusive policy that creates the best value for taxpayers and ensures that all Granite Staters have a fair shot at improving and rebuilding their public infrastructure.

If passed, SB 274 will ensure that any state entity awarding a contract for a public works project, shall not "require or give preference," or "prohibit a bidder, offeror, or contractor in any contractor tier from entering into or adhering to an agreement with a labor organization." This government neutrality leaves the decision of contractor/labor management agreements between the contractor and their labor force. This is the best way to ensure the best possible price, which comes from fair and open competition on state taxpayer-funded projects.

To fully understand the positive impact of SB 274, we first need to recognize the negative impacts of government-mandated PLAs on the construction industry and taxpayers.

Government-mandated PLAs were first utilized in the early to mid-20th century to curtail union-led strikes on massive public works construction projects. During that era, the majority of the construction workforce belonged to a union. PLAs were used as a tool to streamline dozens of collective bargaining agreements covering unionized construction workers and warring local unions on an offer their talents to work on a project. But PLA mandates limit the number of pathways into construction careers. PLAs require merit shop companies to obtain apprentices exclusively from union apprenticeship programs. This means craft professionals enrolled in federal-approved apprenticeship

important jobsite. During this heavily unionized era, granting unionized contractors and union workers a monopoly to build a project in exchange for a nostrike promise via a PLA arguably made sense because strikes were frequent and there were limited alternative sources of construction labor.

In stark contrast, today over 90% of the New Hampshire construction workforce chooses to not belong to a union. PLA mandates unfairly discourage competition from qualified open shop contractors and their employees.

In addition, numerous government-mandated PLAs on local, state and federal projects across America have resulted in litigation, reduced competition, increased costs, needless delays and poor local hiring outcomes and safety records.

We need every worker possible to have an opportunity to programs other than those offered by the union are excluded from working on PLA projects. This provision also eliminates few apprenticeship programs receive preferential treatment? SB 274 protects pathways into construction by ensuring all apprentice programs are given equal opportunity.

Project Labor Agreements should never be mandated by state government; instead, the contractor should be free to voluntarily adopt a PLA if the firm trusts it would help promote economy and efficiency in contracting and help it win the contract and deliver it to the government safely, on time and on budget.

In the federal infrastructure money, we have seen language encouraging government to mandate PLAs. Public construction is expensive enough and we do not need Beltway politics to drive those costs higher. We need to protect small businesspeople and New Hampshire tradespeople from Washington politics. We need SB 274.

TAX AND BUSINESS

K-1, K-2, K-3 – Oh My!

f you have been frustrated with the IRS over the past few years, this is not going to help. If you have a passthrough entity (Partnerships & S-Corporations) you are probably familiar with Schedule K-1 you receive from the business for your personal tax reporting. Beginning with 2021, the IRS has introduced Schedules K-2 and K-3 which are each about twenty pages long and are looking for details of foreign activity at the company level for use in preparation of tax returns at the individual shareholder/partner level. It may seem that the foreign reporting element would not apply, but if one shareholder or partner has investments with foreign tax credits, that would be enough to require the passthrough entity to comply.

These schedules are complex and will be a burden for taxpayers (and CPA's!) to complete. Another IRS requirement with seemingly little to no value for taxpayers. Having to become familiar with these new schedules is one thing, but the kicker is that the IRS will not have these forms ready for electronic filing until March 20th for Partnerships and mid-June for S-Corporations – in both cases after the March 15th due date of these returns!

After dealing with backlash from the CPA community, the IRS has come to its senses and provided interim relief on February 16th. For 2021, you are only required to include Schedules K-2 and K-3 if any ONE of the following situations apply:

- 1. The partnership or S Corp has foreign partners or
- 2. The partnership or S Corp has foreign activity, including Foreign Tax Credits or
- 3. The partnership had information reported on Line 16 or 20C^A for Form

1065, Sch K or the S Corp had information reported on Line 14 or 17d for Form 1120-S, Sch K, for tax year 2020, or

4. The partners or shareholders are requesting the information required to be reported on Schedules K-2 and K-3.

It is important to note that this relief is only for 2021. In this current year relief, you are not required to look through to the individuals receiving the K-1's to see if they have foreign activity, but this will be required in subsequent years. If you believe this will impact you, contact your CPA to discuss how this will be handled for 2021. Some firms have chosen to extend all of these returns and others have chosen to file the K-2 & K-3 for all as a preventative measure.

We all hope the IRS will focus on catching up from these past few years and stop creating new filing requirements that they are not equipped to monitor or even accept. Covid has forced us all to have a bit more patience, but patience for the IRS is running thin in the CPA community.

It is not too late to benefit from the ERTC

The Employee Retention Tax Credit under the CARES Act encouraged businesses to keep employees on their payroll by offering a refundable credit that businesses can claim on qualified wages paid to employees. If eligible, the ERTC provides employers up to \$5,000 per employee during 2020 and up to \$7,000 per employee, per quarter during 2021 (only available through Q3). That is up to \$26,000 per employee! This is a refundable tax credit against certain employment taxes - so even nonprofits can benefit from this program.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE? Using 2019

quarters as a baseline for both 2020 and 2021, you would need to show a 50% reduction in gross receipts compared to the same quarter in 2020 or a 20% reduction in gross receipts compared to the same quarter in 2021 to be eligible. If your business was forced to shut down due to a government order, you may also qualify without meeting the thresholds above. This credit is available to small employers only which is defined as 100 or fewer employees in 2020 or 500 or fewer employees in 2021.

HOW IS THE CREDIT

CLAIMED? This credit is claimed by filing an amended Form 941 for each quarter impacted. We recommend partnering with a firm that specializes in this area to ensure you are playing well with other government programs in place during this period (PPP, EIDL, R&D etc.). The credits obtained are treated as taxable income, but the benefits certainly outweigh the cost. To date our firm has participated in approximately thirty claims which have generated credits ranging from \$30k to \$2M and aggregate total refunds of nearly \$13M! If you think you may be eligible, please give us a call to discuss further.





Avoid Roadway Landmines

As contractors you deal with betting on your own company every day. This includes betting that the next project will come through, betting that safety will prevail and betting that your drivers will not crash.

One thing you probably never think about are the landmines that surround your vehicles from the moment you and your employees leave your office until the moment you secure your vehicles at your jobsite. So much can happen on the roadway in between.

Before I go further, let's first discuss how important it is to ensure that your drivers are properly trained, they have a clean motor vehicle record, your load securement policy and maintenance policy comply or are better than all DOT State and Federal Laws. Even better -if you have a GPS system as well as dashcams that are monitored daily, you are now protecting your company and are ahead of the game!

Congratulations to all of you who are utilizing the aforementioned, defense/safety policies and technology. Your company is better positioned to defend against unwarranted and exaggerated insurance auto claims or as what I like to think of as litigious landmines.

What is a Litigious Landmine?

The following scenario will help you gain a better understanding of the proverbial "landmine:"

Your employee, Tom, has been with you for many years and is a responsible and dedicated member of your team. He is proficient at operating your company's excavator. Tom gears up for the day with his helper. Today is like any other in that they make sure the excavator is fully secured and chained properly on the lowbed.

Tom and his helper then drive out of the yard and are on their way to the job. Ten minutes later while approaching an intersection, a car in front of Tom stops suddenly. Although Tom was keeping his distance, the load he was carrying prevented him from stopping on the dime. This caused him to gently bump the back of the other vehicle.

The single occupant of the car meets Tom and his helper who are already standing in front of their truck. The occupant states to Tom that he is running late for his chiropractor appointment. Tom also thought he smelled alcohol on the other driver's breath. The other driver and Tom looked over their vehicles for any damage. There was only a small indentation to the other driver's bumper. Since the other driver said he was in a hurry and there wasn't any damage to worry about, both parties agreed to go their separate ways. As soon as Tom got back into his cab, he immediately receives a call from the project super telling him to hurry up as everyone is waiting for them to start digging. Tom replied that he was on his way and "never" thought about the minor accident that he was just involved in again.

The Landmine Is Set

Three Years later a sheriff serves a summons and complaint to you containing counts of negligence and personal injury from a motor vehicle accident three years prior. As the employer, you have determined that Tom was involved in the claim. Tom is brought into your office, and he has no recollection of the accident. Now the landmine is about to blowup. Your company has just fallen victim to a M.I.S.T. claim. M.I.S.T., stands for, MINOR IMPACT SOFT TISSUE. M.I.S.T. claims typically occur when the commercial motor vehicle operator fails to report the slightest of accidents and never documents what happened.

The Landmine Goes Off

Little did Tom know that the other party in the mishap took a picture of the lettering on Tom's truck and hired an attorney. The plaintiff's attorney now has a case and can prove your vehicle rear ended his client. The attorney directs his client to seek treatment with a neurologist for his headaches and a surgeon for his back pain.

During the past three years, many diagnostic visits and a few surgeries proved unsuccessful. Further, plaintiff's council negotiated a financial loan with a hedge fund to borrow \$300,000 to cover medical bills and loss wages. This process is called **Litigation Financing** and is designed to achieve larger settlements. To obtain a loan, the plaintiff must prove that the case has merit, and the hedge will be attached to any settlement.

Now with litigation financing involved in the case, the lawsuit against you escalates into a large claim and your defense is weak. If Tom had only taken the time to document what happened on the date of the loss, your company would have had a good defense. With proper accident investigation and documentation, defense council could have revealed that the plaintiff had preexisting back issues from the comments he made to Tom. The smell of alcohol on the plaintiff's breath may have helped with defense too.

The end result is that your insurance carrier will pay a large settlement as nobody bothered to investigate and document the events of the accident that day. Your insurance renewal will not be as pleasant and your company will have lost endless hours of time from having to sit through depositions and the trial.

Lessons Learned and Steps to Take to Avoid Litigation Landmines

Take the right precautions now to not be involved in M.I.S.T claims. Make sure to investigate all accidents and close calls. Invest in decent dashcams and GPS systems. Ensure that your driver selection process constantly monitors motor vehicle records and have all your employees sign off on a comprehensive fleet safety policy. With this in your arsenal, you can disarm landmines before they go off.


