\$500,000 of ApprenticeshipNH Partner Funding Now Available

ApprenticeshipNH has launched new application forms for ApprenticeshipNH Partner Funding opportunities totaling \$500,000.

There are three options available including \$25,000 planning grants, and \$50,000 for the development of pre-apprenticeship or Registered Apprenticeship programs and this funding opportunity will be continuous until all available funds are expended. Prospective partners can submit one, two or all three applications if they are able to meet the contract deliverables of each level.

Reaching School Counselors and Parents

What can we do as an industry to engage educators (counselors, administrators, teachers, ELO/Work-Based Learning Coordinators) and parents in construction career development?

- Construction Career Crawl bus tour of industry employers/job sites
 - School counselors may not have the time outside of professional development days to participate. It was advised we work with the ELO coordinators. A small committee will meet to plan a pilot program in October
- Pathway documents there are many models online we could replicate and brand. What's missing is the classes that students should select that relate to careers in construction

Reaching School Counselors and Parents

- School Open Houses Industry representatives sponsor dinner for parent/teacher events
 - Each school does this differently. We would like to work with one school to run a pilot program in October either in a middle school or high school. Schools interested in exploring this, reach out to communications@abcnhvt.org
- Tuesday Table Talks Industry representatives set up during lunch to share information on their company and career opportunities
 - We are exploring a pilot program at Windham High School. The hope is to host 2 3 construction industry employers this year.
